The St. Leon American Legion will lead the parade around the track with the flag and with the athletes grouped into their individual delegations to follow. The athletes will return to the bleachers immediately after the parade for the rest of the opening ceremonies.

Jereca Fugate will sing the National Anthem - she is to provide her own music.

Towards the the end of the opening ceremonies (9:00 a.m. - 9:30 a.m.) an Indiana State Police Officer will run the torch around the track to light the cauldron - the Flame of Hope at which time I would like either the Chariots of Fire or the Olympic theme played.

Some key times for the band to play:

- 1.) During the parade of athletes
- 2.) **Band featured during opening ceremonies**
- 3.) Running in of the torch - Olympic theme
- 4.) When the games are declared open
